Painting

- Assists with recognising colours
- Problem solving when mixing colours
- Fine motor skills assist with writing

- Teaches children to read and follow instruction,
- Social skills such as taking turns
- Learning about change through heating and cooling
- Food safety and cooking techniques.

Dress-ups

- Develop a sense of who they are,

- Pretending, language skills and imagination.

- Children learn to problem solve
- Understand about space, fill objects, pour, make predictions, be creative and imagine, and talk about early maths.

- Helps with language development & listening skills


